- **Increased Income:** Shampa Hazra now earns ₹12,000-₹15,000 per month from tailoring, significantly contributing to the family's finances.
- **Business Growth:** She has expanded her business by targeting dance schools for dress orders and selling ready-made clothes in Kolkata with her husband's help.
- **Further Investment:** Shampa is reinvesting in her business by taking another loan (₹20,000) in addition to the initial ₹10,000. This demonstrates her commitment to growth.
- **Self-Reliance:** Shampa has achieved her goal of becoming self-reliant and is now a contributing member of the family, supporting her husband financially.
- **Improved Family Well-being:** Her increased income has undoubtedly improved the family's overall well-being and standard of living.
